Jonathan Tompkins will be our Senior Pastor beginning July 1. We look forward to his leadership as we continue to make disciples of Jesus Christ.



St. Andrew By-The-Sea United Methodist Church is excited to welcome its new senior pastor, Reverend Jonathan Tompkins, on Sunday, July 2, 2023.

Rev. Tompkins comes to St. Andrew from serving as senior pastor for 10 years at Travelers Rest UMC. Prior to that, he served as associate pastor of First United Methodist Church in Myrtle Beach. He attended Candler School of Theology, Emory University in Atlanta, and was ordained an Elder in Full Connection with the SC Annual Conference.

"As someone recently told me, any church with by-the-sea in the name sounds like a great place to be," said Rev. Tompkins. "And I agree! Not only is my family looking forward to coming back to the beach, we are excited about establishing ourselves on the island and serving the people of St. Andrew and the greater Hilton Head community, both full-time residents and yearly visitors."

Rev. Tompkins grew up in a small town in the Finger Lakes region of upstate New York but quickly adapted to southern living when he moved to Columbia, SC after graduating college in 1998. He taught seventh grade English at Crayton Middle School for three years, then felt called into youth ministry, serving Shandon United Methodist Church as Youth Director from 2001-2006. It was during his time at Shandon that he joined the United Methodist Church, met Rebecca Neal, who grew up at Shandon and who would later become his wife, and where Jonathan ultimately felt God's call into ordained United Methodist ministry.

Rev. Tompkins has a passion for worship, preaching, teaching, and equipping others for ministry, and enjoys running, biking, fitness, reading, music, strong coffee, and doing all of these things along with Rebecca and their family: Edward (rising 8th grader), Mary Elizabeth (rising 6th grader), and Penny (a 1-year-old mutt). Rebecca is the CEO of Forest Acres Payroll, specializing in providing payroll services for churches and non-profits and is excited to move her business to the island.
