The Healing and Wholeness Service began during the pastoral leadership of Rev. Willie Teague. It has continued each Wednesday for over twenty years.

The service includes dedication of prayer quilts, when requested. We also offer the names of persons on our prayer list, giving a brief time for silent prayer after each name is read. Following the prayers, we celebrate Holy Communion and conclude the service by receiving anointing oil on our foreheads. We are sent into the world to be God's hands and hearts of healing for others.

You are invited to join us any Wednesday you are available as we discover the healing mercy of God while we pray for the healing of others.
