### Navigational Markers (thoughts and ideas to guide you)

#### Prayer as We Put Out to Sea

The Imaginative Prayer Circle: Imagine yourself 'on the ground' and your church family surrounding you, standing behind you. You feel a hand on your shoulder, knowing someone is praying for you. What do you need them to pray for? Offer this up silently before God...

Now imagine yourself standing up, surrounding others 'on the ground,' standing behind someone. Picture who this might be, someone you know in need of prayer. Place your hand on their shoulder and pray for them...offer this up silently before God.
