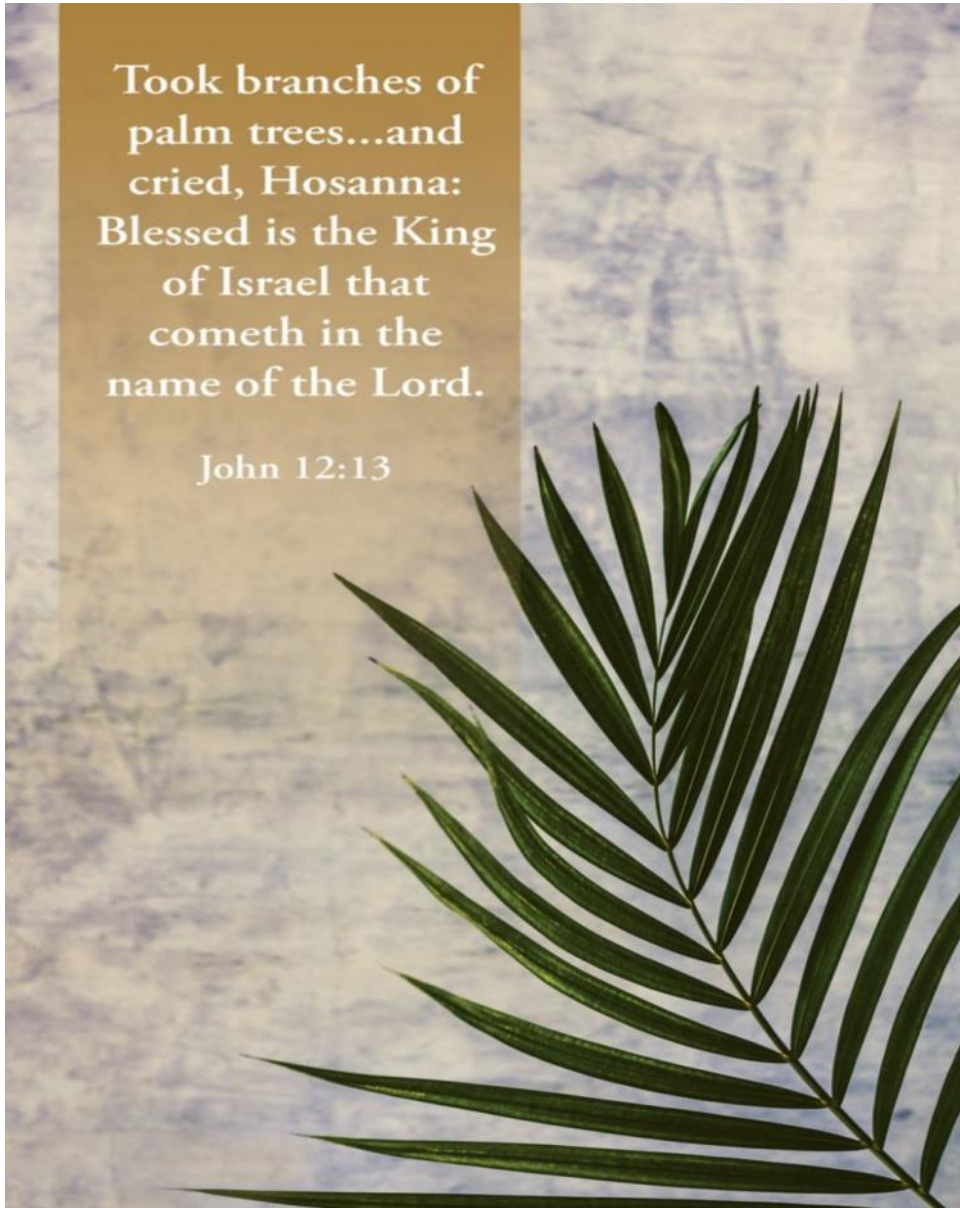

### **Scripture: John 12:12-16** (Common English)

<sup>12</sup>The next day the great crowd that had come for the festival heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem. <sup>13</sup>They took palm branches and went out to meet him. They shouted, "Hosanna! Blessings on the one who comes in the name of the Lord! Blessings on the king of Israel!"<sup>14</sup> Jesus found a young donkey and sat on it, just as it is written, <sup>15</sup>Don't be afraid, Daughter Zion. Look! Your king is coming, sitting on a donkey's colt. <sup>16</sup>His disciples didn't understand these things at first. After he was glorified, they remembered that these things had been written about him and that they had done these things to him.

### **John 18:33-36** (Common English)

<sup>33</sup>Pilate went back into the palace. He summoned Jesus and asked, "Are you the king of the Jews?" <sup>34</sup>Jesus answered, "Do you say this on your own or have others spoken to you about me?" <sup>35</sup>Pilate responded, "I'm not a Jew, am I? Your nation and its chief priests handed you over to me. What have you done?" <sup>36</sup>Jesus replied, "My kingdom doesn't originate from this world. If it did, my guards would fight so that I wouldn't have been arrested by the Jewish leaders. My kingdom isn't from here."
